To achieve this, the authors introduce a coding technique and evaluate its effectiveness using the Hamming code and Reed Solomon coding schemes on a sample data set. The results show that the Reed Solomon coding scheme outperforms the Hamming code in terms of error detection and correction for securely processing DNA records to EHR systems. The next chapter investigates the robustness of AI models trained on thyroid ultrasound images using different convolutional neural network CNN architectures: VGG19, Xception, ResNet50V2, and EfficientNetB2 against adversarial attacks using the fast gradient sign method FGSM, basic iterative method BIM, and projected gradient descent PGD techniques. In the fifth chapter, it was questioned whether artificial intelligence could write an academic article. In this direction, an academic article was created and evaluated by OpenAI ChatGPT. The final chapter proposes an application to measure RF signal intensities in urban areas and use that information to estimate the amount of energy that can be harvested from these signals. This information is then presented to users through a geographical information system.
