STUDY CHALLENGING WORDS TO BOOST YOUR VOCABULARY

If you don't understand the words you're reading, look them up afterward so you broaden your vocabulary.

DON'T TAKE ON TOO MUCH TEXT

If you're just getting started with reading more, don't try and read too much at once, because after a while, it might start to run together. Give yourself 15- or 20-minute reading periods and take breaks after those time periods end.

SUMMARIZE WHAT YOU READ AFTER FINISHING A CHAPTER

A great way to solidify your comprehension of a topic is to summarize what you've read afterward. You can do this by writing a quick summary or talking about it with friends.
