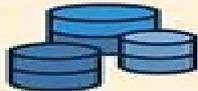

What is the difference between abstract class and interface in Java? An abstract class is a class that cannot be instantiated and may contain abstract methods (methods without a body) as well as concrete methods. It can also contain instance variables and constructors. Subclasses of an abstract class must implement all abstract methods or be declared abstract themselves. An interface is a reference type in Java that defines a contract of methods that a class must implement. It can only contain constant variables and method signatures without method bodies. A class can implement multiple interfaces but can only extend one abstract class.

What is the difference between ArrayList and LinkedList in Java? ArrayList is implemented as a dynamic array, meaning that it stores elements in a contiguous memory location and supports random access to elements using an index. It is efficient for accessing elements by index but less efficient for inserting or removing elements from the middle of the list. LinkedList is implemented as a doubly linked list, meaning that it stores elements as nodes with references to both the previous and next nodes.
