MODULAR CONSTRUCTION

- There are many different ways to define the modular construction but one basic definition of modular construction can be given as follows:
- "Modular Construction is a pre-engineered process of making any structures or elements in a factory that is off-site and are delivered to the sites and assembled as large volumetric components or as substantial elements of any structures."
- It can also be defined as "A modular building is a pre-engineered structure that is flexible enough to satisfy virtually any requirement tougher than standard drywall construction, expandable, can be relocated and completely re-usable."

MODULAR CONSTRUCTION (CONT.)

- With increasing industrialization to the building industry, steadily larger parts of buildings are made up of prefabricated components
