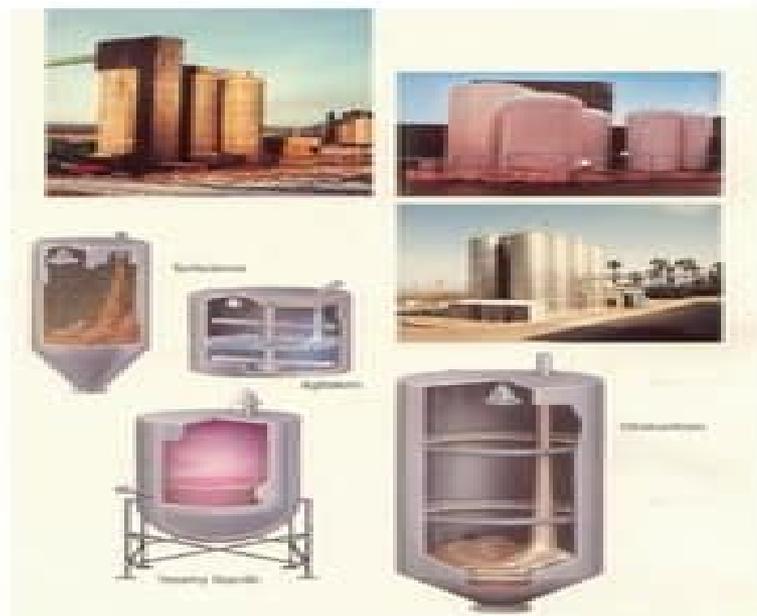


Figure 7.1: Industrial range measurement applications
