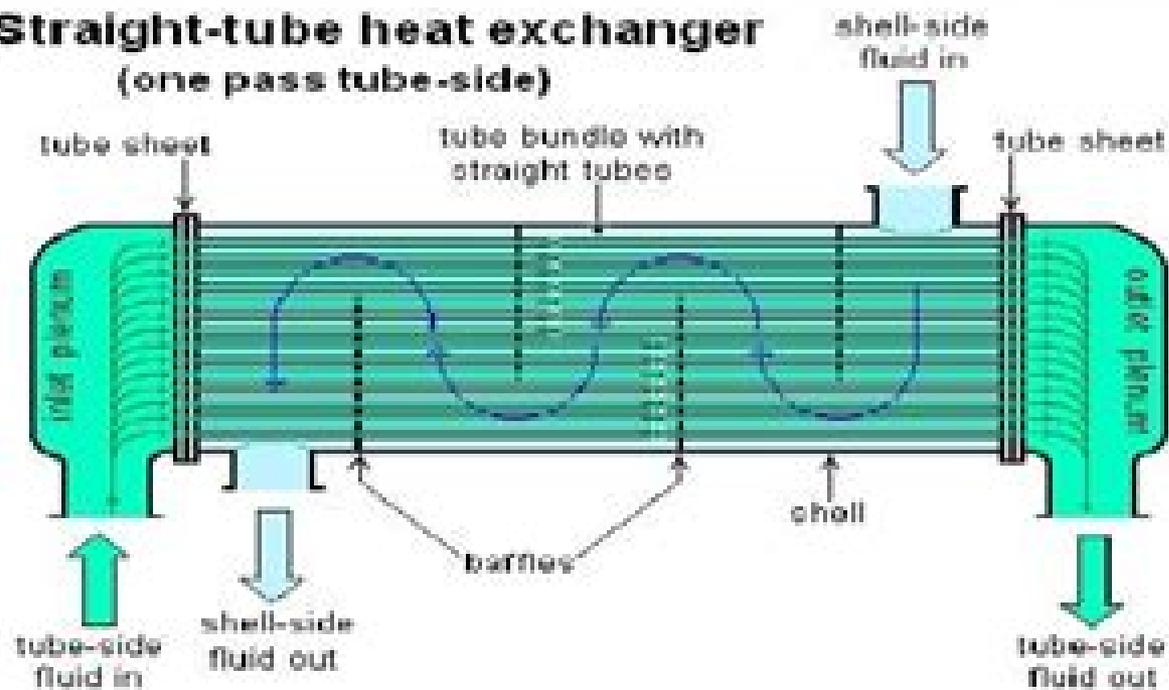


Compact Shell-and-Tube Heat Exchanger
