over time that it had become seemingly real a racial formation and project This was with consequences in that a good part of my actual and psychological labour market and other employment benefits were not part of a meritocratic system but due to the oppression of people of colour This might be part of a system that I at the time associated only with the far right a system of white supremacy Fundamentally my skin was property and the gains that I had made through it were at the expense of others I was a so called white Ignatiev and Garvey 1996 who everyday made a political decision to not commit treason to whiteness
