Chapter 1:

- The European explorers who followed Christopher Columbus to North America had no notion of founding a new nation, and neither did the first European settlers who founded the thirteen English colonies
- Most learned to live lives unfettered by the tyrannies of royal authority, official religion, and social hierarchies that they had left behind.
- Most came determined to create an agricultural society modeled on English customs.
- They also commonly displayed a willingness to subjugate outsiders. Ex: indians
- The thirteen colonies were very different from one another.
- Diversity reigned in New York through Delaware
- Conflicts began over economic interests, ethnic rivalries, and religious practices
- These issues made it difficult for colonists to imagine that they were a single people with a common destiny
- After 1763, the British government, which was financially overstretched, chose to impose taxes on colonies that had been accustomed to answering mainly to their own colonial assemblies.
- In 1775 most people in the colonies hoped that some kind of accommodation short of outright independence, royal intransigence soon thrust the colonists into a war of independence that neither antagonist could have anticipated just a few years before.
- The war in one sense strengthened ties with Britain, since colonial militias fought triumphantly alongside the British army against their mutual French and Indian enemies
- The British made themselves less indispensable to the American colonies by driving the French from the North American continent
- In the end, Americans won the Revolution, with no small measure of help from the French
- In every colony people shared a strong belief that they were fighting for the "unalienable rights" of "life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness."
- The majestic ranges of western North America—the Rockies, the Sierra Nevada, the Cascades, and the Coast Ranges— arose much more recently than others (some 135 million to 25 million years ago).
- The continent was anchored in its northeastern corner by the massive Canadian Shield
