complete reorientation of the discipline in which neoclassical economics hitherto believed irrelevant to developing countries became central. The field started to apply systematically tools such as cost benefit analysis and input output analysis; it also became much more formalized than it was before. The result of this transformation was a much more conventional application of theory to the problem of development. This paper discusses the oscillating nature of development economics.
