#### HISTORY OF THE WORLD SERIES

Baseball has often been called "America's pastime." For more than one hundred years, fans have cheered for their favorite teams, collected baseball cards, and filled stadiums to watch exciting games. At the end of each Major League Baseball season, the two best teams face off in the World Series, a championship that decides who will be crowned the best in the sport.

#### The First World Series

The very first World Series was played in 1903. That year, the Boston Americans, who later became known as the Red Sox, played against the Pittsburgh Pirates. The championship was decided by the best of nine games. Instead of the best of seven we know today, Boston won five games, while Pittsburgh won three, making the Boston Americans the first World Series champions.


Fans loved the idea of the World Series, but it didn't happen again in 1904 because one league refused to take part. Luckily, the event returned in 1905 and has been played every year since—except for 1994, when a player strike canceled the season.

#### Moments

The World Series has provided baseball fans with some of the most memorable moments in sports history. In 1925, Babe Ruth, one of the greatest players of all time, made headlines when he was caught stealing home to end the series. In 1956, Don Larsen of the New York Yankees pitched a perfect game in the World Series—the only one in the history of the sport. In 1980, the Boston Red Sox became the first team to win the World Series after 61 years. In 1988, the Los Angeles Dodgers hit a dramatic home run to win the series. In 1997, the Florida Marlins became the first team to win the World Series after only one season. In 2003, the Florida Marlins won the World Series. In 2004, the Boston Red Sox won the World Series. In 2005, the Houston Astros won the World Series. In 2009, the New York Yankees won the World Series. In 2012, the San Francisco Giants won the World Series. In 2013, the Boston Red Sox won the World Series. In 2015, the Kansas City Royals won the World Series. In 2016, the Cleveland Indians won the World Series.
