



Similar positions with king on the 2nd rank and the pawn on the 7th rank in all other files except on the rook file wins in the same manner.

Note: before moving to the 7th rank rook pawn the readers should know that there is a possibility of draw if the defending rook is allowed to check along the ranks. For this the rook has to be on the longer side of

the pawn and placed at least 3 files apart.






