

The Crime Control Model

- In the crime control model, the control of criminal behavior is by far the most important function of criminal justice.
- The primary focus of this model is on efficiency in the operation of the criminal justice process.
- The key to the operation of the crime control model is "a presumption of guilt."
- In other words, advocates of this model assume that if the police have expended the time and effort to arrest a suspect and the prosecutor has formally charged the suspect with a crime, then the suspect must be guilty.
