widely separated positions on a continuum of countercultural manhood Their divergent criticisms demonstrate that the shift from producerist to consumerist conceptions of manliness was still by no means complete at mid century Furthermore hippies unabashed commitment to masculinity as a natural trait rather than a political and social construct shows how even these incisive and at times impish critics of American culture stood utterly unprepared for the emergence of radical feminism in 1967 and 1968
