- Use stairs or stadium steps for muscle activation.

Incorporate Resistance

- Perform bodyweight exercises at a midpoint or use surroundings (benches, fence posts).
- Try an outdoor fitness circuit for variety.



Extend Your Walk

- Choose specific destinations or vary your route.
- Walk with friends, family, or coworkers for motivation.
- Gradually increase your walking distance each day.
