

Picasso's first known dealer was Pere Manyach whom he met as he travelled to Paris in 1900 when he was only 19 years old. As his representative Manyach went about setting up exhibitions of his works at galleries in the French capital such as Bethé Weills and Ambroise Vollards Picasso's first major exhibition took place in 1901 at Vollards. Daniel Henry Kahnweiler and Leonce Rosenberg came in after Vollard lost interest during the Cubist period as they had a manifest preference for the new style. Like Vollard later dealers often preferred the more conventional Neoclassical phase in Picasso. This was the case with Leonces brother Paul Rosenberg. The book is organized chronologically and discusses the interaction between Picasso's collectors, dealers and exhibitions as they take place. Once collectors acquired an artwork their willingness to lend them to exhibitions or their necessity to submit them to auction had a direct impact on Picasso's prominence in the art world.
