### 2-1 Processing the Crime Scene

- Physical evidence is the keystone for crime labs.
- Physical evidence encompasses any and all objects that can establish that a crime has been committed or can provide a link between a crime and its victim or a crime and its perpetrator.
- The presence of physical evidence must first be recognized at the crime scene for it to be used effectively.
- Crime labs do not solve crimes, but enhance the ability of police officers to have successful outcomes for their criminal investigations.
- Forensic science begins at the crime scene.
- The investigator must be able to recognize physical evidence and properly preserve it for lab examination, or it will be useless.
- Crime-scene investigation techniques are not difficult to master and are easy enough for the average police officer to perform.
- A crime scene is processed in a certain order:
  - **SECURE & ISOLATE THE CRIME SCENE**
    - The first officer to arrive at the scene is responsible for securing the crime scene, seeing if anyone needs medical assistance, and arresting the perpetrator.
    - The highest priority must be made to exclude all unauthorized personnel from the scene to avoid destruction or contamination of evidence. Barricades, ropes, and police tape are often used, along with police guards.
  - **RECORD THE CRIME SCENE**
    - Once the scene is secured, the preliminary exam must begin. Recording of the crime scene becomes a critical piece to the investigation process, and the opportunity to record the scene in its original state must not be lost.
    - Investigators have only a limited amount of time to work a crime site in its untouched state.
    - The opportunity to permanently record the scene in its original state must not be lost.
    - Such records will not only prove useful during the subsequent investigation but are also required for presentation at a trial in order to document the condition of the crime site and to delineate the location of physical evidence.
    - Every step of the investigation should be documented thoroughly with an appropriate method.
    - Documentation of the crime scene is required for presentation as evidence at trial and to show where the physical evidence was found.
    - Photography, sketches, and notes are the three methods for crime-scene recording, and all three should be used when budget and personnel allow.
      - Photography
        - \* A crime scene must be in an unaltered condition before being photographed. Nothing must be moved until it has been photographed from all necessary angles or it may not be admissible at trial. (The only
