Emil Cioran:

Siena Teresa of Avila and Saint John of the Cross have produced classic works of mystical literature but Cioran celebrates many more minor and unusual figures as well. Following Nietzsche he focuses explicitly on the political element hidden in saints' lives. In his hands however their charitable deeds are much less interesting than their thirst for pain and their equally powerful capacity to endure it. Behind their suffering and their uncanny ability to renounce everything through ascetic practices Cioran detects a fanatical will to power. Like Nietzsche Cioran is an important religious thinker.
