THE MEANING OF FREEDOM

- James A. Garfield asks "What is freedom?"

Blacks and the Meaning of Freedom

- Freedom meant escaping slavery and sharing rights with White Americans.

Families in Freedom

- Black institutions expanded

Church and School

- Blacks abandoned white religious institutions and created their own.
- Blacks flocked to schools made by Northern missionary societies, Freedmen's Bureau, and groups of former slaves.

Political Freedom

- Frederick Douglass said that freedom is not free until given the right to vote.
- Some parts of the south allowed Black votes, while others did not.

Law, Labor, and Freedom

- Ideas of freedom were related to land ownership.
- Blacks seized property in 1865, claiming that it belonged to them.
- Blacks viewed freedom as self-ownership, family stability, religious liberty, political participation, and economic autonomy.

Masters without Slaves

- White southerners reacted to the emancipation with dismay. There was widespread devastation and commands from the North.
- More than 1/3 of the South's adult male white population died in the Confederacy.
- Southerners viewed freedom as a privilege and not a right.

The Free Labor Vision

- Republican North tried to implement its own vision of freedom.
- The idea of free labor: Emancipated blacks with the same opportunities as Northern Whites. South would eventually resemble a "free society" just as the North. Public schools, small towns, independent farmers. Planters establish a labor system, Economic autonomy and access to land.
