[VERTEBRATE] an animal with a bony or cartilaginous backbone

[DESCENT WITH MODIFICATION] Darwin's term for evolution, combining the ideas that all living things are related and that organisms have changed over time

[FOSSILS] the preserved remains or impressions of once-living organisms

[FOSSIL RECORD] an assemblage of fossils arranged in order of age, providing evidence of changes in species over time

 - a. Mosquito:
Since the mosquito does not have a hard body it would probably be buried in amber.
 - b. Lizard:
A lizard has hard, bony parts so it would probably be fossilized by mineralization.
 - c. Hermit crab:
Since a hermit crab has a shell it would probably leave an imprint or mold in the mud that then hardens.

(3) If the organism is eaten or broken down by aerobic microbes, bacteria, or water no fossil will form. It is more likely for a fossil to not form because the conditions have to be perfect for a fossil to form.
