This month, the Centre hosted a visit from twenty-five second year student nurses from the School of Healthcare at the University of Leeds who came to observe our children. Millipedes have been particularly interested in learning about hospitals lately, and had a fantastic time with their visitors, learning about stethoscopes and syringes and role-playing with dressing up scrubs and first aid kits. A week later, they invited groups of our children to visit the Baines Wing of the University of Leeds to spend some time in their simulated children's ward! For the student nurses, the visit was a really valuable opportunity to gain experience in interacting with children, particularly putting them at ease in a hospital environment, and our children had a fantastic time, learning how to use medical equipment like stethoscopes and thermometers, and learning all about what it is like to visit a real hospital.

We also celebrated both Pancake Day and Lunar New Year! For Pancake Day, Butterflies did some mixing, using mixing spoons to stir flour and water together to make their own sticky pancake dough. Caterpillars experimented with edible materials in a tough spot, mark-making with paint brushes and a yummy mixture of blueberries, raspberries, cornflour and water. Millipedes designed their own pancakes, using paint in different colours to simulate the ingredients on a round paper pancake template - they used red paint for lots of yummy ingredients, such as jam and strawberries, and used lots of brown paint in lieu of chocolate! Like Butterflies, Dragonflies made their own pancake dough and cut them into shapes using biscuit cutters. They even made their own chocolate sauce to put on top!

This year's Lunar New Year was the celebration of the Year of the Dog, and Playscheme kicked off our activities with a visit from Homer the guide dog. Caterpillars set up a colourful sensory tough spot, mark marking with pasta and rice in vibrant red and gold colours. Ladybirds made an incredible dragon and had tea parties throughout the week, sampling different kinds of tea. Butterflies did beautiful paintings on red paper, got messy playing in noodles and lots of red and gold glitter! At reception, we had real fortune cookies for tasting and put out some Lunar New Year storybooks for our families to read together.

Lastly, the very end of February saw us hit by an avalanche of snow! We made the most of it, spending lots of time in the garden building snowmen, making snow angels and igloos, and throwing snowballs! We even painted the snow!
