

LED Intensity Measurement (Case Study)

Challenge

In a recent application our customers needed to test LEDs in commercial fixture systems. The fixture light consisted of an array of 120 light points and LEDs. The fixture light operated in a high-intensity mode called "stage mode" and a low-intensity mode called "ball mode".

When the LEDs were in "stage mode" their measurement system would activate.

In order to commission this, several dummy filters were used to diffuse the LED intensity to a level acceptable to the test system. However, when operated in "ball mode", the activation of the control during filter removal (intensity) in the measurement of LED output and intensity.

Solution

The solution was to use the Flux LED Analyser in conjunction with Flux Optical

Studio. The Flux LED Analyser has an extremely wide dynamic range which allows it to test LEDs from the dimmest LED (0.1) up to the brightest LED, without the use of any external optical attenuators or filters (at least 200 lumens). The Flux DMF LED Analyser was connected together in a daisy chain configuration in order to test 120 LEDs simultaneously.

In this particular case the customer opted to use the X1 chrominance and luminance camera from the Flux LED Analyser. Flux provided a comprehensive suite of software tools which allowed to adjust the Flux LED Analyser after it was fixed in the test fixture. This allowed that each filter was measuring the correct intensity and colour. By using the most advanced camera technology it was possible to achieve a repeatability of $\pm 0.001\%$ in CIE X and Y chrominance and a repeatability of $\pm 1\%$ in terms of intensity measurements with a linear relation between it and ball mode.

One of the biggest challenges when setting up this test fixture was determining the test filter to use. It was decided that the best method was to test a large quantity of PCBs and using the measurement to calculate the mean and standard deviation of each filter position. Two filters were determined using the mean values as measured by the Flux LED Analyser and the MinMax techniques were derived from the relevant LED data sheet.

In order to ensure that the LEDs were thermally stable the LEDs were pre-warmed for a fixed time before any measurement was made.

Result

Using the Flux balancing software it was then possible to adjust the mean intensity value of each filter to compensate for any fixture variations. A golden thread (chrominance thread) was created and the measured value for each filter was stored. This thread was then used to verify the test fixture each day to ensure that there was no drift in the test results.

After drying of the test fixture the test time was approximately 1.5 seconds for the high intensity test and 1.0 seconds for the low intensity test of all 120 LEDs. The customer reported a new operational procedure from the Flux LED Analyser in terms of both colour and intensity measurement. See Flux Case Study below.
