The next chapter investigates the robustness of AI models trained on thyroid ultrasound images using different convolutional neural network CNN architectures: VGG19, Xception, ResNet50V2, and EfficientNetB2 against adversarial attacks using the fast gradient sign method FGSM, basic iterative method BIM, and projected gradient descent PGD techniques. In the fifth chapter, it was questioned whether artificial intelligence could write an academic article. In this direction, an academic article was created and evaluated by OpenAI ChatGPT.
