It continues with explaining the concept of persuasive language on the basis of ethos, logos, and pathos and introduces some powerful persuasive techniques in advertisement. Further, linguistic devices of persuasive language on the phonetic, lexical, morphological, and syntactic level will be defined. Additionally, the concept of Critical Discourse Analysis will be explained in detail as the thesis at hand follows the CDA framework of Fairclough. The data collection method and data analysis procedure will be outlined in Chapter 3. This is followed by an analysis of three online native advertisements from the publisher The New York Times.
