Lines and segments are written with two letters and a line over the top (arrows for lines)

RAYS

Rays are written with two letters and a line with an arrow pointing to the right over them

ANGLES

Angles have the angle symbol (∠) and three letters after the symbol

EXAMPLE



PLANES

Planes can be named by writing the word plane and three letters after the word

EXAMPLE

plane ABC

SEGMENT ADDITION

If three points are collinear and B is between A and C, then $AB + BC = AC$

EXAMPLE



ANGLE ADDITION

If B is in the interior of $\angle AOC$ then $m\angle AOB + m\angle BOC = m\angle AOC$
